SENATORS UDALL AND HEINRICH CONTINUE ASSAULT ON BORDER SECURITY

Beginning with the introduction of Senate Bill S.1689 on September 17, 2009, followed by S.1024 on May 19, 2011 and S.1805 Organ Mountains-desert Peaks Conservation Act, on December 12, 2013, Senators Bingaman, Udall, and Heinrich and their surrogates have repeatedly attempted to convince the citizens of New Mexico generally, and of Dona Ana County New Mexico specifically, that adding approximately five hundred thousand (500,000) acres of land to Wilderness and/or national monument designations while reducing Border Patrol access to the border would be a “good thing”.

The National Association of Former Border Patrol Officers was asked to provide an intelligence based assessment of legislation proposed in S.1689. That assessment was first presented on August 18, 2012 and has the same validity today relating to S.1805.
